2. [Statement for Defunding SDCCD Police Positions](#) The letter read at the meeting differed from what was originally posted in the Minutes. [HERE](#) is the letter that was read. Foster read the attached statement and provided context, questions and responses about the statement. There was pushback based on criticism against the police. The resolution is a small step against the history of oppression. Other districts have moved to non-renew school district's sheriffs' contracts. The Academic Senate is being asked for their support. There was discussion on the statement. Some examples of discussion included: Not defunding but more training, deeper background checks and continuous psychological examinations. People in the police force experience trauma so we should address that. Defunding of police without a solution is not a solution; maybe a mediator for someone in crisis. Police has had to be called to classes with unfavorable results. Experiences with students with mental health crisis. We need funding to go to hiring mental health crisis counselors. The San Diego Police Department (SDPD) is trying to recruit from the neighborhoods that are being patrolled so officers understand the communities they will serve. SDPD has hired Mental Health Facilitators. We (our district) should consider following in this path before we request to defund our own SDCCD police department. Rather than "defunding" we should consider "refunding". In other words, shift funding and look at alternate ways that would serve each of our unique campuses. SDCE does not have any mental health counselors like our sister credit schools do. Mesa college crime statistics were shared. Questions were posed on who an instructor would call in a mental health situation (911 or mental health counselor). If we added "college" to our name, we may be able to collect a health fee to address some of the issues and receive additional resources. Motion to support the letter: M. Leppert, 2nd by E. Claar. There was discussion. Motion to postpone the vote: R. Gholson, 2nd by L. Marlow. There was discussion. The letter will be read Thursday, 12/17/2020 at the Board of Trustees (BOT) meeting. The BOT meeting starts at 4:00 pm.
