[Here is the link](#) to the draft 2020-21 final allocation for CAEP by regional consortia. The Governor signed a 2020-21 budget that gave CAEP an additional **\$54,356,000**. The additional funds will be added to the approved May Revise reduction in NOVA. Please review the attached amount for your consortium and let TAP know if you have any questions or concerns.

The State CAEP Office plans to upload the increased amount listed on the attached sheet in NOVA by tomorrow – July 2, 2020. It is critical, especially for direct funded consortia, that you meet and agree to the allocation amounts, by member, as soon as possible. The state will need to lock in this amount for the disbursement schedules due in early July.

Consortia will have until August 14, 2020 to complete the allocation amendment in NOVA. However, direct funded consortia will need to let me know as soon as possible if you agree to the allocation amounts, by member. Remember, education code still applies for member reductions or increases (see EC 84914).

Fiscal Declaration

The Fiscal Declaration information in this section has been provided as a courtesy. It has not been changed since CFAD has been approved by the Member Representatives.

Consortium Name: 48 San Diego Adult Education Regional Consortium

Funding Channel: Direct Funded

Narrative: The SDAERC is using an annual allocation method based on a percentage split that was developed when the consortium was first formed: SDCE receiving 75% of the funding allocation and SDUSD receiving 25% of funding allocation. This allocation takes into consideration the size of the Adult Education programs offered by each member in terms of the number/percentage of students. Consortium member data shows that SDCE is currently serving approximately 98% of the total Consortium headcount being reported to CAEP. Additionally, the SDAERC has acknowledged funding levels needed to maintain and sustain AE programming with SDUSD. The SDAERC planned allocation to members is based upon the budgeted and planned expenditures that utilize funds efficiently and that are justifiable and reasonable.
