Apprenticeship Readiness Program Graduates 13th Cohort

In November 2024, the Apprenticeship Readiness Program reached an exciting milestone with the graduation of its **13th cohort**. This year, **21** dedicated students successfully completed the program with the skills and knowledge needed to take the next steps in their careers.

Accomplishments:

- The program has reached its 13th cohort, equipping students with the tools to excel in the trades.
- This cohort includes 21 newly trained individuals, ready to contribute to their communities.
- Graduates are already taking steps toward union membership, showing their preparedness to begin impactful careers in the industry.

PATHWAYS PROGRAM

Pathways, a retention model program for SDCCE's homeless students designed to create educational communities that provide intensive and direct student support services, is wrapping up yet another successful grant cycle. Over the last two years, Pathways has served **99 participants** and over **120 affiliates** with a variety of services including assistance for basic needs, transportation aid, and job placement services.

Many of Pathway's students have persevered and succeeded in a variety of ways! **68** participants have secured and/or maintained employment and **52** participants have improved their housing situation during their time in Pathways. We are proud of each and every student in the Pathways program and their dedication to achieving their educational and employment goals, and Pathways is excited to serve more students in the coming years!



CALWORKS & TOYS FOR TOTS HOLIDAY SUPPORT

Toys for Tots, a program run by the United States Marine Corps Reserve, provides toys to children whose families are unable to afford gifts for Christmas. In support of this initiative, the Foundation is donating **100 gift cards** to students in the SDCCE CalWORKs Program.

This collaboration between CalWORKs and Toys for Tots ensures that students receiving public assistance through the San Diego College of Continuing Education can give their children holiday gifts. The gift cards offer families the flexibility to select appropriate gifts for older children, while also alleviating some financial pressure and meeting essential needs.

NEW BOARD MEMBER SPOTLIGHT


