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PURPOSE

The San Diego College of Continuing Education (SDCCE) requested the Office of Planning, Research, and Institutional Effectiveness (PRIE) conduct a study with the following objectives:

1. Gain situational awareness regarding changes in enrollment plans among students already enrolled for in-person classes during Fall 2022.
2. Measure the impact of the recent COVID surge in enrollment plans among students considering changing their decision to attend in-person classes during Fall 2022.
3. Emphasize SDCCE's commitment to ensure the health and safety of its students to students considering changing their decision to attend in-person classes from SDCCE during Fall 2022.
4. Measure the comfort level in receiving in-person classes and services among students considering changing their decision to attend in-person courses from SDCCE during Fall 2022.
5. Identify potential actions to increase students' level of comfort in receiving in-person classes and services during Fall 2022.

METHODOLOGY

- Type: Online survey, confidential
- Campaign: 2-week open, invites/reminders sent out via generic emails and texts through the app "*EZ-Texting*" from the Office of Student Service (OSS)
- Survey provided in English and Spanish
- Potential Populations A and B:
 - A. SDCCE students who are enrolled classes in Fall 2022 (approximately 5,895 as of 08/22/22)
 - B. SDCCE students enrolled in Fall 2021, Spring 2022, or Summer 2022 but not enrolled in Fall 2022 (approximately 11,211 as of 08/22/22)

PRIE conducted online data collection among SDCCE students throughout August 2022. A total of 2,211 surveys were completed.

RESULTS

Table 1 shows the total number of students for each group of the population who answered the survey.

The survey was answered by 1459 students in population A and 752 in population B.

There are five categories for each population. The first category consists of students who study Career Technical Education (CTE) (e.g., Automotive, Business and Accounting, Child Development, Clothing and Textiles, Digital Media and Programming, Healthcare, Hospitality, and Culinary Arts, Information Technology Skilled and Technical Trades). The second category consists of students studying a CTE like Disability Support Programs and Services, Emeritus (for age 55+), English as a Second Language/Citizenship, and High School Diploma/High School Equivalency and Basic Skills are considerate Non-CTE. The third category consists of students who are considered as Adult Basic Education (ABE), Adult Secondary Education (ASE), and English as a second language (ESL); These students are enrolled in English as a Second Language/Citizenship and High School Diploma/High School Equivalency programs, and they are in the category “ABE+ASE+ESL”. In the Forth category, Basic Needs Flag, consists of students who faced financial situations during the last 12 months. Finally, the Digital Pillars Flag category consists of students who faced problems attending online classes.

Some results are presented below. For instance, 96% of own students plan to attend in-person classes at SDCCE this Fall in population A (see question 1); meanwhile, 77% of population B plan to attend SDCCE this Fall (see question 10). Students are unsure and decided to attend in Fall 2022, 14% of population A are concerned about COVID-19 cases (see question 2), and 7% are worried about the rise in COVID-19 cases from population B (see question 11).

One of the most important reasons for students from population A was concern about COVID-19 cases with 14% (see question 3). On the other hand, 24% for students from population B was that their job responsibilities prevented them from attending classes (see question 12).

Furthermore, 17% of own students feel safe and healthy with SDCCE's measures from population A (see question 4), and 44% of student population B does not feel safe and comfortable (see question 14). Among students that were concerned about COVID-19 and did not feel comfortable, there was a question about what SDCCE can do to make it safer. The results showed that 50% and 33% answered that there is nothing can be done (see questions 5 and 13).

Students from population A scored 4.7 and population B scored 3.4 on a scale from 1 to 10 when asked about attending in-person classes this Fall (see questions 6 and 15). Sixty-three percent (63%) of students from population A agree regarding online classes with set meeting times (see question 9) and 47% for students from population B (see question 18).
