- **Goal 1: Building Bridges for Transition aka Create and Enhance Student Centered Transitional Pathways, within and between Member Agency Institutions**
 - Develop introductory courses as part of career pathways for students to explore different career opportunities (1bii.)
 - Participate in FELI/College and Career Readiness
 - Explore possibility to train SDUSD teachers in FELI
 - SDUSD have instructors sign up for December session
 - Alignment of INTD/courses at SDUSD
 - Develop and begin implementation of practices that address student barriers by offering student supports and guidance (1ci.)
 - Utilize the SDG2CC Model for SDUSD AE and Transitioning students
- **Goal 3: Improve and Enhance Data Driven Decision Making**
 - Utilize Human Centered Design (HCD) as an approach to solving design challenges (3e.)
 - Use data to inform/assess the effectiveness of intake and onboarding
 - Improve SDUSD access to programs at SDCE
 - Track transitions and success rate

- College open houses held at each of the credit campuses
- Gateway to College and Career Program
- Outreach ambassadors
- Counseling 1x1 Appointments with students
- Career counseling
- CTE materials supports with student equity funding
- HHSA County eligibility enrollment screenings Rising to Success Centers
- College Ambassadors

In the works:

- SDUSD referrals of TRACE students to DSPS

Matters Most:

- **Expand Curriculum (1b.)**

In process:

- ABE working with ESL Program Chairs to create basic skills for CTE students
- ESL developing Integrated Education and Training VESL cluster modules and measuring transitions to CTE
- Instruction developing Introductory Courses for CTE
- Pathway Coordinators creating a “Pathways Inventory “
- Reviewing LMI for current CTE pathways and new CTE programs

Matters Most:

- **Develop CTE Pathways**

In process:

- ESL Integrated Education and Training (IET) under Integrated EL Civics of WIOA II class and VESL Cluster courses
- Inventory being developed by Pathways Faculty Coordinators
- Review of LMI for current pathways and new CTE programming
- Introductory/Foundational CTE courses

Matters Most:

- **Create Opportunities for WBL (1c2.)**

In process:

- Pre Plan for WBL being developed by WBL Faculty Coordinators
- Determine how we use Business Advisory Councils
- CTE courses do in class WBL with industry
- WBL Coordinators creating an inventory of WBL
- Cal Works funds work-study student worker positions
- SDG2CC subsidized internships

Matters Most:

- **Relationships with Employers (1e4.)**

In process:

- College and Career Transition Team of Job Developers are new
- Job Fairs
- CTE Instructors maintain relationships with employers

Goal 2: Create and Enhance Recruitment and Outreach Efforts, within and between Member Agency Institution

Matters Most:

- **Enhance Recruitment Common Onboarding Processes (2a.)**

In process/Opportunities:

- Orientation email blasts
- Website access
- Outreach efforts at schools and community
- Student Services are looking at various onboarding practices by program and looking at a redesign
- Student services is doing a chart of the journey to identify challenges

Matters Most:

- **Enhance Recruitment by hosting tours and open houses with parents and students (2b3.)**

In process/Opportunities:

- Counselors working with local High Schools and AE program
- One on one relationships between counselors
- Outreach Coordinators have a scheduled meeting with District Outreach coordinators
- Social media
